Gareth Bale made his professional debut at the age of 16 years and 275 days. He played for Southampton against Millwall. On 1st September 2013, Gareth Bale signed for Real Madrid for a record transfer fee of £84.7 million. This eclipsed the previous record of £80 million that Real Madrid paid for Ronaldo in 2009.

Bale scored his first professional goal against Derby County on 6th August 2006.

Bale is on front cover of FiFA 14.

Bale was born in July 16 1989

On 20th October 2010, Bale recorded his first ever hat-trick, by scoring all of Tottenham's goals against Inter Milan at the San Siro

On 1st September 2013, Gareth Bale signed for Real Madrid for a record transfer fee of £84.7 million. Harry Redknapp, one of Gareth Bale's managers at Tottenham, believes that Bale is in the same class as Ronaldo and Lionel Messi.

Gareth Bale has played more than 40 matches for Wales, scoring more than 10 goals.

Bale made 45 appearences for Southampton, scoring five goals, before moving to Tottenham Hotspur on 25th May 2007. Bale started off playing the left-back position, but he became a left-sided midfielder / winger as his career progressed.

He is fame for his pace, his crossing ability and the accuracy and power of his left-foot shots.

His footballing hero was Ryan Giggs.

Brownies

(Nepali Rice Pudding)

Ingredients

By Aakarsh

1 cup rice

1 cup half and half (alternate: use whole milk)

2 cups whole milk

1.5 cups sugar

1 teaspoon cardamom

2 tablespoon unsalted cashews

Optional

2 tablespoon cashews

½ teaspoon Elachi powder

½ teaspoon Saffron

Preparation:

1. Cook rice with whole milk.

2. Add half and half, sugar cashews and spices

3. Boil for a few more minutes.

4. Serve hot.

Witch's cookies

Ingredients:

400g Flour

200g Cornflour

400g Butter

200g Caster Sugar

od:

1. Put all the ingredients into a mixing bowl and mix together.

2. When all the ingredients are mixed, roll out the mixture.

3. Cut witch shapes out of your dough. You can buy special cookie cutters or cut out cardboard templates yourself. Some ideas include a witch's face, witch's hat or even a witch's broom.

4. Put on a baking sheet and chill for 20 minutes.

5. Pop into the oven for 15-20 minutes until pale golden.

6. Cool on a wire rack

7. Make the white icing by mixing the icing sugar with one tablespoon of warm water – the icing should be thick to allow you <u>spread</u> it on the cookie with a knife. Don't make it too runny – if you do, add more icing sugar.

8. Divide the icing into separate batches and add different food colouring so you can decorate your cookies. You can also add jellies or any edible decorations.

Ingredients

175g/6oz Odlums Cream Plain Flour

225g/8oz Butter or Margarine (room temperature)

125g/4oz Chocolate

325g/12oz Caster Sugar

2 Teaspoons Vanilla Essence

4 Eggs (batter)

100g Packet Shamrock Chopped Walnuts

Pinch of Salt

½ Teaspoon Baking Powder

Method

1. Preheat oven to 160°C/320°F/Gas 3. Lightly grease an oblong brownie tin. 25cm/10" x 15cm/6". Small roasting tin would also do.

Melt the butter or margarine and chocolate together over a low heat.

2. Remove from heat, add the sugar and mix well.

3 Add vanilla essence, eggs and (chopped walnuts if you want)

4. Sieve the flour, salt and baking powder together and gently stir into chocolate mixture.

5. Pour into prepared tin and bake for about 40-50 minutes until crusty on top.

6. Remove from oven and allow to cool, cut into brown-

Chocolate Eclairs

You'll need:

65g Flour

Meth-

150ml Water

50g Margarine

A pinch of salt

2 eggs (beaten)

To decorate you'll need:

50g chocolate, melted with 25g of margarine

Preparing time: Baking time:

15 minutes 20 minutes

Method:

Preheat an oven to 200°C/400°F/Gas 6 and grease a flat baking tray. Place water and margarine into a saucepan over a low heat until margarine melts.

Bring to a brisk boil.

Reduce heat and add sieved flour and salt.

Stir briskly until mixture forms a soft dough and leaves sides of saucepan. Remove from heat and allow to cool.

Add the eggs gradually and beat until mixture is smooth and shiny.

Transfer mixture to a piping bag, fitted with a 1/2" plain nozzle.

Pipe 4" lengths of mixture (well spaced) onto the prepared tray. If piping bag is not available, just spoon mixture onto tray!

Bake for 20 minutes approx, until well risen and golden brown in colour. Remove from oven and slit along one side. Cool on wire tray.

When cold, fill with whipped cream and spread with chocolate on top.





DSPCA Animal Hero By Daniel

Chasing a pot-bellied pig around Aras an Uachtarain's grounds, tracking a seven-foot snake in a public park and rescuing a fox trapped in a basement – it's all in a day's work for animal welfare officer Gillian Duffy. At 9am the headquarters of the Dublin Society of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (DSPCA) is already a hive of activity. Calls for help are flooding into the control room, the hub of the centre's operations. Demands on its services have never been as great, up by 51% in the past 12 months. Lorna Swift, who is usually the voice at the other end of the phone, said: "The number of calls to our centre have increased beyond our capacity. The control room is where it all begins. We take the call and then assess what to do next." Where cases of animal cruelty are suspected, it's a job for the inspector and when animals have been abandoned, injured or lost the welfare officer is sent to investigate. Animal Welfare officer Gillian Duffy has seen a lot in her seven years with the organisation but she is still shocked sometimes at the level of torture she sees." There is a saying Cruelty was one part of the job I really was clueless about before I came here. Whatever I thought it was like, multiply that by a million."
