## Covid-19 Summary For Parents



This is a short summary of our full Response Plan for easy reference. You can read our full Response Plan on the school website.

-  School hours are: surnames A-K arrive at **9.10-9.20**, surnames L-Z arrive at **9.20-9.30**. Junior Infants, Senior Infants and First Class arrive from **9.30-9.40**. Further details available on your email.
-  2nd-6th class children will go straight to their line. Parents can leave them at the designated area maintaining 2m distance.
-  Junior Infants to First Class can be brought to their external classroom door, maintaining 2m distance.
-  Pick up from designated area, as outlined on the school website, maintaining 2m distance.
-  Pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.
-  Collection of children during the school day by prior appointment only.
-  There will be no access to the classroom for parents or visitors, bar exceptional circumstances.
-  All staff will complete COVID induction training.
-  As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a face covering when within 2 metres of another person.
-  Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using proper technique.
-  Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit and during the school day.
-  High-touch points will be cleaned during yard breaks. Classrooms will be cleaned daily. Toys will be disinfected regularly.
-  Pupils must be kept home with **high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell**. Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.
-  Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.
-  If showing symptoms, pupil will be isolated and parents called. Parents will be advised to contact their GP.
-  Each class is one bubble. Within each bubble there will be pods to limit the extent of close contact within a bubble.
-  Physical distancing will be maintained in senior classes as much as possible.
-  Each pod will have separate resources. Children will keep one pencil case in school and another at home.
-  Any shared resources will be wiped down at the end of the day.
